## Vice President's Report

Our May meeting gives members the opportunity to propose changes to our bylaws. In order to do this, you must show which bylaw you wish to change. For example: Article V, Section 1. Regular meetings shall be held at [10 a.m.] 9 a.m. on the third Saturday of January, May, September, and November.

As you can see, you must include the article and section you wish to change. You can also submit a new paragraph to a bylaw, but it still must be in the same article and section. A new section can be proposed.

All bylaw changes must be given to the Laws Committee before or during the May meeting. Once submitted the Laws Committee will meet to see if the changes are worthy of the change. They may or may not recommend the change. They may recommend a change with an amendment of their own.

At the September meeting the Laws Committee will go over their report and the members can discuss the Laws Committee report and agree or disagree with that report.

The next step will be going before the whole membership to vote on the changes by referendum vote. The members have the final say in whether a bylaw should be changed or not.
