## Report of the President

Happy, peaceful, and prosperous New Year to all.

In January 2021 I was given the honor to serve as president of Columbia Typographical Union No. 101-12. Since that time, we have been able to reduce our Local's overall expenses and will continue to look for additional ways to further reduce our expenses going forward. Unfortunately, the biggest problem we continue to face is with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) over the Local's taxes not being filed on time. When we met with the IRS in December 2021 to resolve this issue, we were hopeful this matter would be resolved within a matter of months. Unfortunately, the IRS continues to send letters to the Local requesting additional time on this matter. We are now in the process of trying to set up an in-person meeting with the IRS.

### **2023-2024 BYLAWS REFERENDUM**

The Local will be mailing out the Bylaws Referendum ballot in mid to late January. Members are reminded to have their current mailing address on file with the Local to ensure they receive their ballot. Members should return their ballot as soon as possible to ensure it is received before the closing date of February 28, 2024. Any ballots received with a postmark later than February 28, 2024, will not be included in the final count.
