#### **GOVERNMENT PUBLISHING OFFICE (GPO)**

The current wage agreement between GPO and the Joint Council of Unions will expire at the end of 2025. With the last three or four wage contracts, Columbia Typographical Union 101-12 has participated with the Joint Council of Unions in negotiating a new wage agreement with the GPO.

The GPO has reached out to the Joint Council of Unions with their wage agreement proposal for 2026-2030. The current GPO proposal is for 5 years instead of 4 and will continue with pay raises by the same percentage according to General Service (GS) employees in the Washington, DC, area.

This wage proposal negotiation is crucial as it will determine the wage structure for the next five years. Your support and input are vital to ensure a fair and beneficial agreement for all parties involved.

Members are encouraged to attend the May 24, 2025, Union meeting to discuss the GPO's current wage proposal.

Updates and detailed information regarding negotiation meetings and progress will be provided as they become available.
